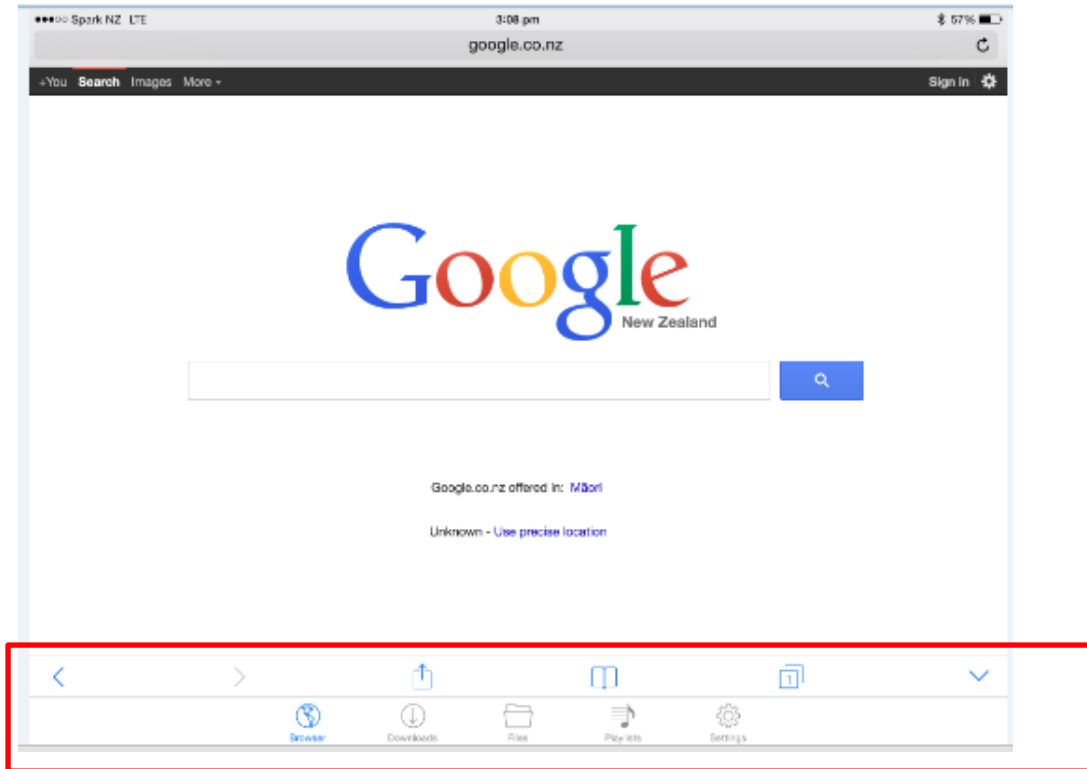


DOWNLOADING VIDEOS ON AN APPLE DEVICE

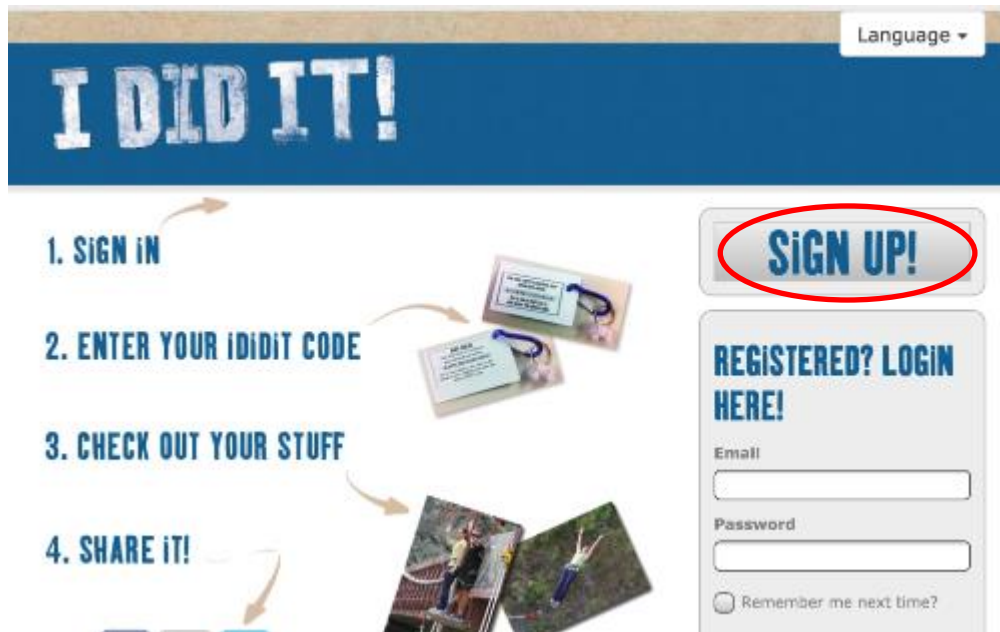
1. Apple App Store- search for “Video Downloader from AppsNeon”



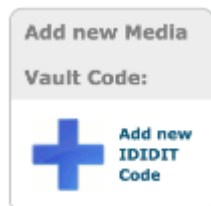
2. The app looks like a browser, however there are extra functions at the bottom of the menu



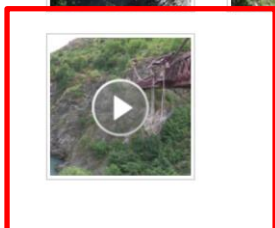
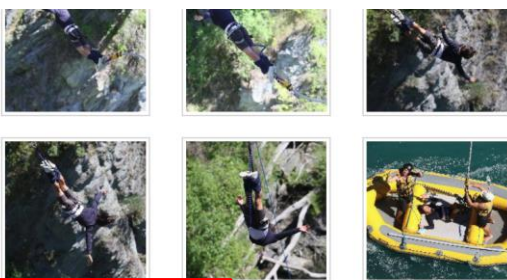
3. Change the URL to www.ididit.co.nz/bungyhome, using the App.



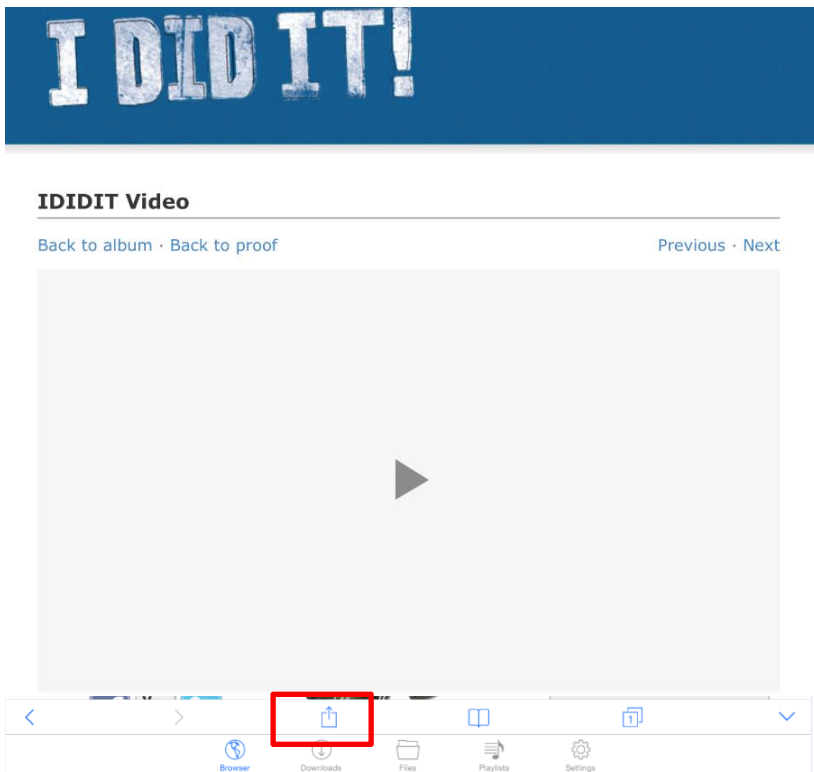
4. Click on 'Sign up' to our ididit website, follow the instructions to create a login.
5. Click the 'Add new IDIDIT Code' and type in your Code from the card given to you on-site at your Bungy or Swing activity with us. This may take a while to load, depends on your data speed and the strength of your internet connection.



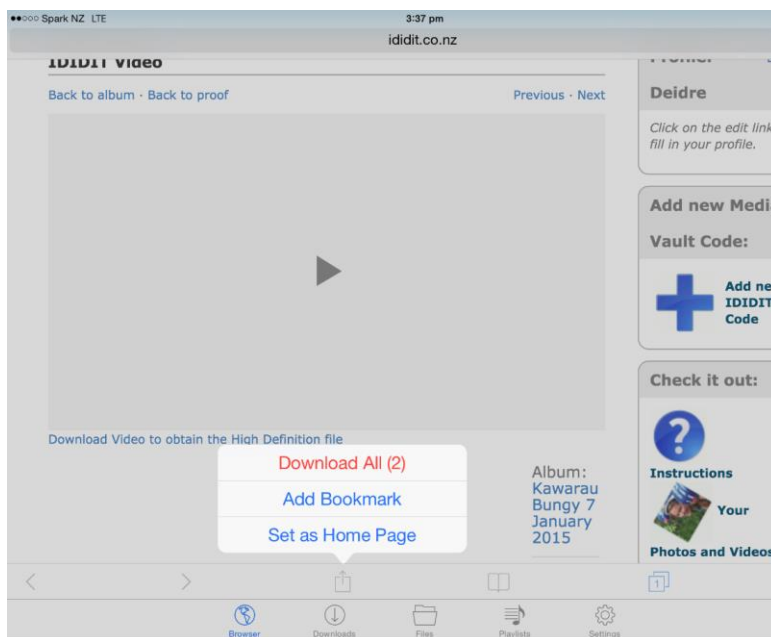
6. Click on the Video icon (looks like a PLAY button), the other images are your photos.



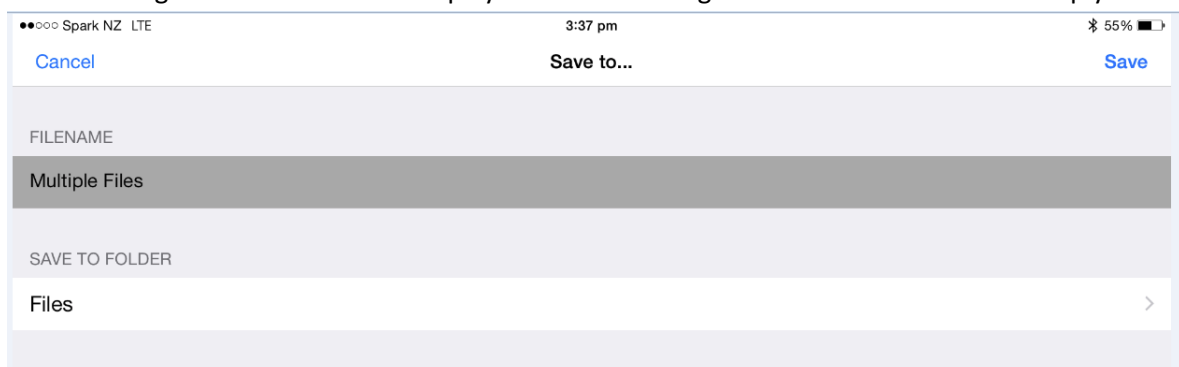
7. The video will 'Play'(see example below)- Click the icon in your App as shown below (it's an IOS output icon)



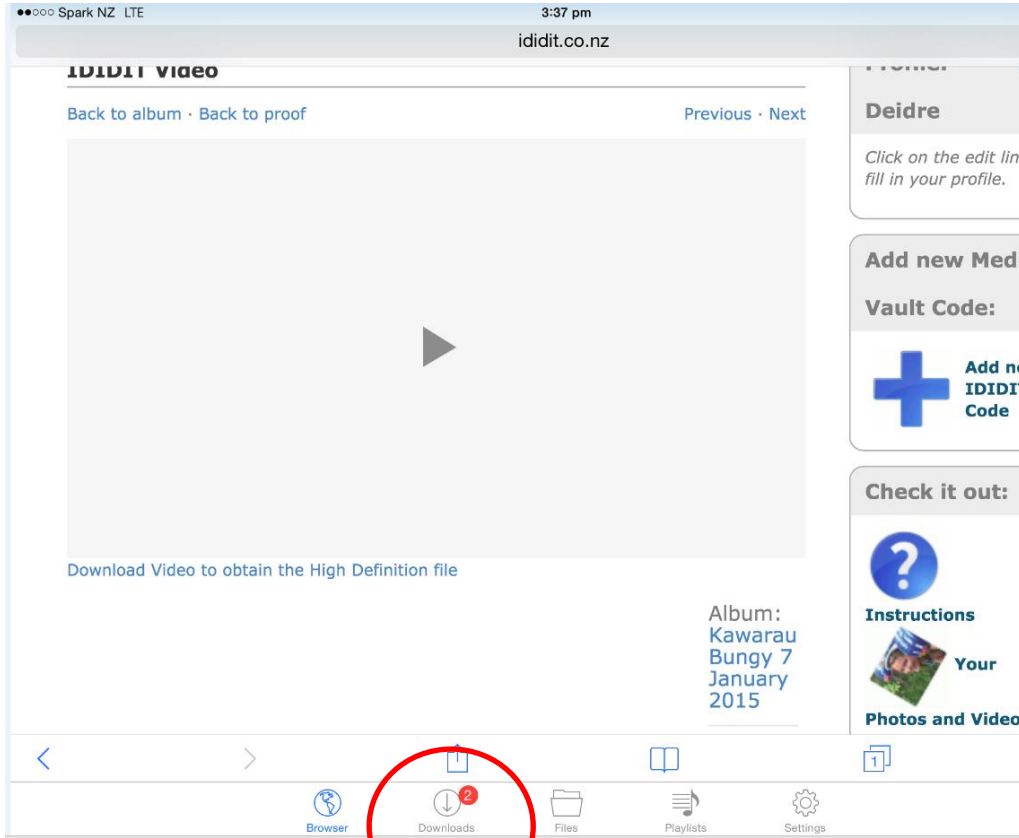
8. Click 'Download All (2)'



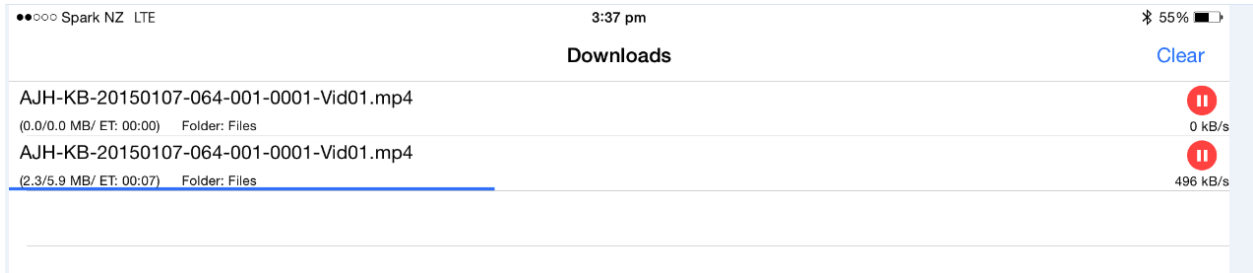
9. The following 'Save Menu' will be displayed. You can change FileName and Folder OR simply 'Save', as is.



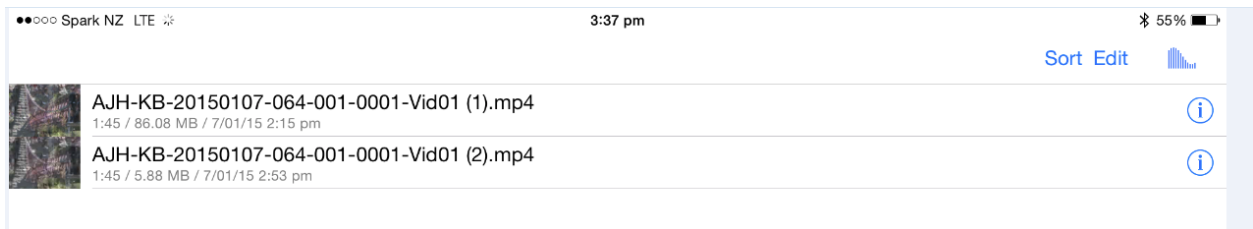
10. Files will start downloading – there will be a ‘Low Resolution .mp4’ and a ‘High Definition .mp4’.




11. Click on the Downloads icon (see above example) to see the full information on the files being downloaded.



12. Once downloaded, you can access and play the files from the ‘Files’ Menu



Note that you can click the  icon to bring up options on how to view or send that video file on your IOS Device.

13. The video files are now on your local device to play through the Application from now on without connecting to the internet!
